I. Outstanding Research Careers

This event will be hosted by V4 Research & Innovation in Brussels with the participation of the Young European Universities Network (YERUN) and will be dedicated to talks with speakers representing both the European Commission and the community of early and mid-career researchers. The invited researchers will present their research careers and analyse the challenges of today's research landscape and address issues related to mobility, career development, skills and employment. Their experiences are highly relevant to current policies on research careers in Europe both at the national and EU levels.

II. Webinar about Institutional and Departmental Young Academies

In the last 23 years, there has been a positive increase in the number of national young academies and similar bodies which are now present in 68 different countries. There are also 4 regional or global young academies with transnational membership such as the Global Young Academy or the Young Academy of Europe.

Surveys conducted among EMCRs often indicate that young scholars feel excluded from strategic decisions of their own institutions or departments. In countries where trade unions have no strong traditions and activities, junior faculties, institutional or university young academies may help EMCRs advocate for themselves. Such organisations also can have more diverse roles, including promoting networking among EMCRs, mentoring or science outreach, or helping improve the university or institute brand and public image.

In this webinar with representatives from institutional young academies, there will be discussed the best practices of such organisations compared to national and transnational bodies.

III. Consolidator Grant- ERC-2024-COG

The ERC Consolidator Grants are designed to support excellent Principal Investigators at the career stage at which they may still be consolidating their own independent research team or programme. Principal Investigators must demonstrate the ground-breaking nature, ambition and feasibility of their scientific proposal. The Host Institution (Applicant Legal Entity) must engage and host the Principal Investigator for at least the duration of the project, as defined in the grant agreement. It must either be established in an EU Member State or Associated Country. Consolidator Grants may be awarded up to a maximum of EUR 2 000 000 for a period of 5 years.

IV. Co-Designing Diamond Open Access Recommendations and Guidelines for Research Funders, Sponsors, and Donors

Science Europe is organising a co-design process to develop diamond open access recommendations and guidelines for research Funders, Sponsors, and Donors (FSDs) in the context of the Horizon Europe project 'Developing Institutional Open Access Publishing Models to Advance Scholarly Communication' (DIAMAS). Having identified the fragmentation of the diamond open access ecosystem, this project aims to facilitate cohesion and alignment by formulating community-led recommendations and guidelines for institutional leaders, FSDs, and policy makers in Europe.

This meeting will provide a briefing on the development of diamond open access developments in Europe and beyond, discuss opportunities and challenges for FSDs, and have a first exchange on co-designing recommendations and guidelines.

The organizers will count on the valuable presence of the Ethics and Integrity Sector of the European Commission, as well as colleagues who will share their experiences, problems, and strategies in helping researchers to manage ethical issues in proposals and projects.

VI. Public Engagement with Research Award

The call for the ERC Public Engagement with Research Award 2024 is available for those Principal Investigators, who carried out public engagement or science communication activities in the course of their project or up to two years after its end. Public engagement with ERC-funded activities involves the public in project design, conduct, and dissemination, fostering mutual understanding for mutual benefit. As mentioned, all applications must refer to public engagement activities for an ERC-funded project, regardless of the sources of funding for the public engagement activities themselves, moreover they should be sufficiently mature to demonstrate impact. Up to six prizes will be awarded under this work programme of a value of €10 000 each.

- **How will plants adapt to a high CO2 world?**

The International Union of Biological Sciences (IUBS) organizes the fifth lecture in the frame of the IUBS Centenary Webinar Series, which will be delivered by Christine H. Foyer, School of Biosciences, College of Life and Environmental Sciences, University of Birmingham, UK. In the webinar, there will be introduced the topic of climate change, the greenhouse effect and greenhouse gases, and how scientists measure the impact of high atmospheric carbon dioxide concentrations in crops and forests using Free-Air Carbon dioxide Enrichment (FACE) sites, among others.
