I. Nyílt pályázati felhívás a Fialat Kutatók Akadémiája tagságra – 2024 (Open call for applications for membership of the Academy of Young Scientists – 2024)

A Fialat Kutatók Akadémiája (FKA), a Magyar Tudományos Akadémia (MTA) közfeladataival összhangban működő, alulról szerveződő tudományos társaság, mely az MTA tudományos osztályaival szorosan együttműködve részt vesz annak tudományos közéleti tevékenységében. Az FKA tevékenysége a következő fő területekre összpontosít: a hazai fiatal (45 év alatti) kutatók érdekeinek képviselése hazai és nemzetközi szinten; a tudományos kiválóság elősegítése; a tudomány és a társadalom közötti kommunikáció erősítése.

Az aktuális tagválasztás során 12 fő nyerhet felvételt az FKA-ba, mely pozíció betöltésének kezdete: 2024. május 1.

II. Survey: Help shape the future of research management in Europe

The survey developed in the framework of the RM Roadmap project (funded by Horizon Europe) will help shape the future of research management in Europe, by supporting the recognition and professionalisation of research managers. Each input is crucial to provide valuable recommendations for the professionalisation of research management.

This survey builds on previous surveys, primarily on the RAAAP (Research Administration As A Profession) series, and will focus on job profile, career path, skills and competencies, as well as training, mobility, and networking opportunities.

Participants contribute to building an inclusive definition and terminology including RM professional categories; developing career development frameworks for RMs; creating skills and competence matrixes specific to research management; and establishing a comprehensive training scheme for future research managers.

Collected data will be shared via online open access repositories (Figshare and Zenodo) after thorough anonymisation. Results of the research will be also published open-access in research reports and possibly in peer-reviewed scientific publications which shall include the characterisation of the national professional communities. It is also important to ensure a representative participation of the national professional communities in the field of research management.

Participation is anonymous and the survey takes approximately **25** minutes to complete.

III. MSCA Doctoral Networks 2023- HORIZON-MSCA-2023-DN-01-01

The MSCA Doctoral Networks aim to train creative, entrepreneurial, innovative and resilient doctoral candidates, who are able to face current and future challenges and to convert knowledge and ideas into products and services for economic and social benefit. MSCA Doctoral Networks will implement doctoral programmes, by partnerships of universities, research institutions and research infrastructures, businesses including SMEs, and other socioeconomic actors from different countries across Europe and beyond.

Both supported doctoral candidates and participating organizations benefit from the programme. The former acquire new transferable skills and competences, enhanced networking and communication capacities with scientific peers, meanwhile the latter gain improved quality, relevance and sustainability of doctoral training programmes, increased integration of training and research activities between participating organisations etc.

IV. MSCA COFUND 2023-HORIZON-MSCA-2023-COFUND-01-01

MSCA COFUND co-finances new or existing doctoral programmes and postdoctoral fellowship schemes with the aim of spreading the best practices of the MSCA including international, intersectoral and interdisciplinary research training, as well as international and cross-sectoral mobility of researchers at all stages of their career. In practice, MSCA COFUND provides complementary funding for doctoral or postdoctoral programmes managed by entities established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries. Applicants submit proposals for new or existing doctoral or postdoctoral programmes with an impact on the enhancement of human resources in R&I at regional, national or international level. These programmes will be co-funded by MSCA COFUND.
