II. Fulbright Specialist Program

The Fulbright Specialist Program is open to qualified U.S. scholars and professionals in specific fields of study. The program awards grants ranging from two to six weeks and will make use of serial grants.

Fulbright Specialist activities will be designed to provide U.S. faculty and professionals with opportunities to collaborate with professional counterparts on curriculum and faculty development and institutional planning. Furthermore, grantees may conduct needs assessments, surveys, institutional or programmatic research, take part in specialized academic programs and conferences in conjunction with other scheduled activities, consult with administrators and instructors of post-secondary institutions on faculty development, present lectures at graduate and undergraduate levels, participate in or lead seminars or workshops at overseas academic institutions, develop and/or assess academic curricula or educational materials, conduct teacher-training programs at the tertiary level, etc.

Application deadline: at least **three months** before the planned project date.

IV. Webinar for researchers interested in applying for the MAPS

MAPS is one of three funding instruments offered by the SNSF as part of the Second Swiss Contribution to selected EU member states, that is it aims to strengthen research collaboration between Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Poland, Romania, and Switzerland. MAPS will be implemented through Joint Research Projects (JRPs) that promote clearly defined goals, involving at least one applicant based in Switzerland and two to five additional applicants from two to five of the participating EU-13 countries. Research is carried out at the respective research facilities involved, while reciprocal visits and short stays may also be supported. The maximum amount of funding for each team in each country is 350,000 francs for a duration of three to four years.

Organized by SNSF, this webinar is designed to researchers who are interested in applying for the MAPS to provide details with regards to their application.

V. Horizon Europe strategic plan 2025-2027 for research and innovation to underpin journey to a green, digital and resilient future

The Commission has adopted the second strategic plan for Horizon Europe which was announced at the flagship Research and Innovation Days. It sets out three key strategic orientations for EU's research and innovation funding for the last three years of the programme (2025-2027): green transition; digital transition and a more resilient, competitive, inclusive and democratic Europe. The strategic plan provides an overview of the achievement of EU Missions over their first years and identifies nine new European co-funded and co-programmed partnerships. In April 2024, the Commission will launch a feedback opportunity for the Work Programme 2025 open to all stakeholders. You can read more about the strategic plan [Here](#).

VI. STOA workshop: 'Strategic autonomy and the future of nuclear energy in the EU: Use and availability of HALEU'

The EU is currently transforming its energy system and at the same time is facing several challenges: meeting increased electricity demand, while mitigating environmental impacts and geopolitical instability that affects security of supply. This workshop is an opportunity to engage in a discussion on the potential role of advanced nuclear technologies within this complex matrix.

The event aims to explore the advancements and challenges of nuclear energy, with a particular focus on a specific nuclear fuel High-Assay Low-Enriched Uranium (HALEU) and from the strategic autonomy point of view. Given the scarcity of information on high-assay low-enriched uranium (HALEU), this workshop will offer a comprehensive overview of the latest advances in reactors that use this nuclear fuel.

To pilot a "big science approach" to sustainability challenges, the International Science Council invites novel, innovative, collaborative consortia to co-design and embark on Science Missions for Sustainability as well as visionary funders and partners to join and support this bold collaborative effort. Furthermore, scientific organizations, policymakers, non-governmental organizations, communities, and the private sector, working on the cutting edge of identifying solutions for complex sustainability challenges, to co-design targeted Science Missions for sustainability over an initial 18-month period are also invited to the initiative.

The selected Pilots will demonstrate the value of truly collaborative transdisciplinary efforts in helping fast-track the achievement of the SDGs and accelerating societal transformation to sustainability.
