IV. Trends in Implementing AI in Research Organisations & Legal Aspects - Workshop

Artificial Intelligence is increasingly relevant in the research ecosystem as it has the potential to revolutionise research and innovation by accelerating the discovery of new knowledge, enhancing decision making and prediction, automating routine tasks, and facilitating cross-disciplinary collaboration. However, the increasing use of AI in research also raises ethical, legal, and societal issues that need to be carefully considered and addressed.

In this workshop, participants will explore the multifaceted impact of AI and its regulation in research activities and research management. Building on the outcomes of the first internal discussions, Science Europe will bring together experts and representatives from Member Organisations to share their experiences, concerns, and ideas related to the ethical and regulatory aspects of AI in research and innovation. There will be also discussed best practices and case studies of ethical AI in research and showcase convenient approaches and strategies for addressing ethical challenges and dilemmas.
