I. RFCS Info Day Annual Calls 2024

The Research Fund for Coal and Steel (RFCS) is a EU funding programme aiming to support research and demonstration projects in the coal and steel sectors. For coal, it supports the just transition of the coal sector and regions, in line with the Just Transition Mechanism, and contributes to improving health and safety and minimizing the environmental impact of coal regions in transition. As for steel, it supports breakthrough technologies for low-carbon steelmaking, in line with the objectives of the Horizon Europe Clean Steel partnership, and promotes the conservation of resources, the protection of the environment, and the circular economy, as well as the management of workforce and working conditions.

The info day gives the opportunity to get more information on the topics of the calls for proposals and to learn the best practices for a successful submission. It is also an occasion to discuss potential project ideas, synergies, and network.

II. EU TalentOn

Initiated, funded and co-created by the European Commission, EU TalentOn is one of the biggest brainstorming events happening in Katowice, in the European City of Science 2024. The 2024 edition, taking place between 9 and 14 September, is open to young researchers aged 21-35, representing all scientific disciplines, who will team up to develop innovative solutions responding to actual societal challenges.

During the 4-day hackathon, the young researchers will be asked to team up and respond with the best possible scientific solutions to a problem in the area of any one of the five missions of the European Union included in the Horizon Europe programme. Topics to be chosen are the followings: Adaptation to Climate Change, Cancer Prevention and Care, Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030, 100 Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities by 2030, and Soil Deal for Europe.

The winning team will be rewarded a cash prize from a total prize pool of EUR 75.000.

III. Call for experts to participate in the IPCC Scoping Meeting for a Methodology Report on the Carbon Dioxide Removal Technologies and Carbon Capture Utilization and Storage

The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) has invited the International Science Council to nominate experts to participate in the scoping meeting for an IPCC Methodology Report on the Carbon Dioxide Removal Technologies and Carbon Capture Utilization and Storage, to be held by the IPCC Task Force on National Greenhouse Gas Inventories (TFI), and tentatively scheduled for the second half of October 2024.

This scoping meeting will make a recommendation on the Scope of the Methodology Report for consideration by the IPCC Panel in early 2025. Following the decision of governments, a Methodology Report shall be prepared through the course of four Lead Author Meetings with the final report to be considered for acceptance by the IPCC Panel by the end of 2027.

IV. Call for nominations of experts: Providing scientific advice within the Biological Weapons Convention

The International Science Council is partnering with the Implementation Support Unit of the Biological Weapons Convention (BWC) on a project to strengthen the bridge between science and policy by bringing together distinguished scientists, academics, and diplomats to prepare the ground for a stronger science-policy interface within the BWC.

Organisers expect nominations of authoritative experts specializing in Science and Technology Advisory Mechanisms relevant to the fields of disarmament and life sciences, Verification and Compliance of Biological Weapons related activities, and International Cooperation and Assistance under international conventions. Selected experts will

participate in several online meetings from September to October, culminating at the in-person BWC meeting in Switzerland in December.

The experts must be nominated by a Member organization of the ISC or a partner organization of the ISC, and will receive an honorarium of 2 000 Euros for their work.

The 22nd World Congress 2024 of the International Union of Food Science and Technology (IUFoST) will be held in Rimini, Italy from 8 to 12 of September 2024. The programme will include industry-based workshops, distinguished plenary and keynote speakers, industry led concurrent sessions, applied research presentations and a plethora of networking opportunities since are expected to attract more than 2,500 delegates worldwide.

The congress aims to outline the new challenges that the sector will face. For this reason, the multi- and interdisciplinary meeting of all the scientific communities, which too often operate isolated from each other, will be welcome.

VI. IUPAC 2025 Distinguished Women in Chemistry or Chemical Engineering Awards

The International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry (IUPAC) announces the call for nominations for the IUPAC 2025 Distinguished Women in Chemistry or Chemical Engineering Awards. The purpose of the awards program is to acknowledge and promote the work of women in chemistry and chemical engineering worldwide. The current award ceremony will take place during the 2025 IUPAC Congress in July in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

Awardees will be selected based on excellence in basic or applied research, distinguished accomplishments in teaching or education, or demonstrated leadership or managerial excellence in the chemical sciences. Each nomination requires a primary nominator and two secondary nominators who must each write a letter of recommendation in support of the nomination. Self-nominations are not accepted.
